Four VIPOC board members, including Paul Monteiro (Netherlands), Georg Pliszewski(Germany), Nicolle Maquignon (France), and Jean-Marie Meurant (France), actively participated in discussions around the advancement of vitiligo awareness and treatment. The conference saw 15 communications, 51 posters, and 17 speakers, with notable meetings between JM Meurant and Dr. Henry Lim discussing coalition building, as well as productive engagements with pharmaceutical organizations like ABBVIE, INCYTE, and PFIZER.

The Europe Summit yielded promising support for advocating better recognition of vitiligo and ensuring equal access to treatments.

Additionally, the Vitiligo Task Force (VTF) meeting was led by Pr Nanja Van Neel and Julien Seneschal, covering pivotal topics such as FDA approval for cellular therapies like RECELL and the progress of the VITAL Project, aiming to standardize vitiligo assessment worldwide.

The VIPOC members also had fruitful meetings with Karen Férez from Mexico and new

VIPOC members from Sri Lanka, Vitiligo SriLanka and Skin SriLanka, some are committed to attending the Cairo conference, further solidifying the global collaboration for vitiligo advocacy and treatment.






Germany
